Our vision is that previously incarcerated women leaving prison who have a strong desire to restart their lives need to have a home base where they feel supported and welcomed back to the community and to have a path to permanent housing and sustainable employment.

Our housing program is unique and we have found success in our structure. Our Home Base is not intended for short-term or emergency housing. Housing up to 2 years and residents are expected to contribute to household expenses and rent. We do not discriminate based on crime of conviction, race, color, religion, sex (including gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, and sexual harassment), disability, familial status, or national origin.
